



St Vincent de Paul Annual report

The SVDP receive significant funds from Government- \$67,893,000 to support homeless, mental health, housing and disability services. Donations and appeals were \$24,368,000 (this includes partnerships with businesses and the Vinnies Community Sleepouts). Bequests last year were \$8,650,000.

** There are 220 Vinnies shops and 6 distribution centres in NSW, generating \$91.7 million over the last financial year. Customers served- 4,367,265. Items sold-10,761,436 and 3,717,371 of donated textiles were received and sorted.

The Vinnies Finds e-commerce platform was launched in 2025.

**The cost for the centres of charity and other was \$68 million.

**Fundraising costs for 2025 was \$4.5 million.

**There are other income revenues and associated costs that I haven't mentioned. Total income for 2025 was 230 million and expenditure was 225.5 million.
